



## PET POLICY

The Resort at Cypress Hills recognizes that your dog is an extension of your family and is pleased to welcome them. We offer dog-friendly accommodations in all of our outdoor units. Due to the increased sensitivity of allergies, we strongly encourage you to keep your dog off the furniture and out of the beds, preferably keeping them out of the bedrooms entirely. To ensure that both your stay and the stay of future guests remain comfortable, please review our pet policy guidelines.

- A non-refundable fee of \$25 plus applicable taxes per dog per night will be charged.
- A maximum of 2 dogs per unit.
- To prolong the longevity of the furniture and linens and to ensure the comfort of future guests, we respectfully ask that you refrain from allowing your dogs on the furniture and in or on the beds. If unavoidable, we kindly request that you bring pet blankets or sheets to cover these areas. Pet blankets are available at the Front Desk.
- By Saskatchewan Provincial Parks regulations, dogs must always be leashed and controlled. Pets must be up to date with vaccinations and registered with their local municipality.
- Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs, both inside and outside the unit, and properly disposing of the waste. Dog bags are available around The Resort property.
- Dogs are not permitted inside the hotel rooms, the hotel lobby or event spaces. Registered service dogs with accompanying certification are permitted.
- Dogs are not to be left unattended inside or outside the unit. Noise and disruptive disturbances will be communicated to the dog owner and rectified immediately. Should your dog create a disturbance affecting the comfort of other guests, an additional charge of one night's accommodations may result.
- To ensure the safety of your dog and the efficiency of our team, please coordinate with the Front Desk for housekeeping or maintenance services. These services will only occur when you and your dog are out of the unit.
- If your unit requires excessive cleaning after your stay or has incurred damages due to your dog, The Resort reserves the right to charge additional fees for extra cleaning services and/or repairs. Please be mindful of your pet's behavior to avoid these charges.

Upon your arrival, you will be asked to acknowledge that you have received, read, and understood the pet policy as presented to you. Should you have any questions about your dog during your upcoming stay with us, please get in touch with a Front Desk agent before your arrival. All fees are subject to change at the discretion of The Resort.
